He leaves behind one great-grandson, Arthur J. Cliette Jr.; two great-granddaughters, Cassandra Cliette and Gena M. Roche; two great-grandchildren, Chandler James and Chelsea L. Cliette; as well as several nieces, nephews and many friends.
