AN OLD RESIDENT OF GLYNN COUNTY DIED EARLY TODAY

Mrs. L.H. Drury, an old and well known resident of Glynn county, passed away at 1:30 o'clock this morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. H.A. Bell, near Bladen. She had been in ill health for many years and for the past two or three weeks her condition has been serious.

The deceased was born and reared in Camden county, and came to this county shortly after her marriage to Mr. Drury in 1877. Since the death of her husband in 1900 she has resided at the old home near Brookman. She was a life long member of the Methodist church and was well known among many friends, throughout the county.

Mrs. Drury is survived by seven children as follow: Mr. Steve Ferrell and Mrs. F.A. Smith of the city; Mrs. A.L. Little of Atkinson, Mrs. J.C. Davis, of White Oak; Mrs. H.A. Bell of Bladen; Leighton Drury, of Brookman, and Julian Drury, of Miami. A son and a grandson of the deceased passed away only a few weeks ago.

The funeral will be held Wednesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, the interment to be in the old family cemetery. Rev. J.W. Patterson and Rev. C.J. Johnson will have charge of the service and Undertaker Baldwin will conduct the funeral.
