LEIGHTON DRURY OF BROOKMAN DIES EARLY TODAY

Leighton H. Drury, 84, died early today at the Brunswick hospital. A life-long Glynn County resident, he resided at Rt. 1 Brookman.

He was a retired farmer and a member of the Emmanuel United Methodist Church where he served as an honorary trustee.

Survivors include his wife, Mrs. Leola Arnette Drury; four daughters: Mrs. Hazel Reddick, Mrs. Isla O'Quinn, Mrs. Edna Kahler and Mrs. Alma Tompkins, all of Brunswick; three sons: William L. Drury and Tommy Drury of Brunswick and Ronald L. Drury of Douglas; a sister, Mrs. H.A. Bell of Brunswick; 34 grandchildren; 40 great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held at 3 p.m. Wednesday at Emmanuel [sic] United Methodist Church with the Rev. Ralph Spivey and Dr. Basil Ossipoff officiating. Interment will be at Drury Cemetery on Emmanuel Church Road.

Grandson will serve as pallbearers. Honorary pallbearers will be Dr. Hurley Jones, Dr. A.W. Jones, Dr. Arthur Hagan, Dr. Don R. Roberts and trustees of Emmanuel [sic] Church.

The family will be at Chapman Funeral Chapel from 7 to 9 p.m. today to receive friends. The body will be taken to the Drury home at 3 p.m. Tuesday and will be placed at the church an hour prior to services.
