Charlton Scott Jr., 76, of St. Simons Island died Tuesday at Hospice of the Golden Isles.

A native of St. Simons Island, he was a graduate of Risley High School and served in the U.S. Air Force. During his tenure, he achieved the rank of Technical Sergeant and received President Sigman Rhee Citation honors. After an honorable discharge from the Air Force he was employed by the U.S. Post Office in Compton, Calif. He was a lifetime member of the NAACP, Compton Division; the Urban League of Los Angeles, Calif., and the American Legion of Brunswick.

Graveside services will be held at 3:30 p.m. Saturday at Gould Cemetery on St. Simons Island.
